I had the pleasure of joining Nicole Turner at the Inaugural South Australian Library and Information Awards Ceremony at the State Library in Adelaide.

This event showcased and recognised the very best of what South Australian Libraries and library staff have to offer. Speaking to Geoff Strempel, Director of the State Library, who was also part of the judging panel he advised me that they had received around 30 incredible applications of innovation, initiative and collaborative practice from around the state. The calibre of the nominees was incredible and to listen to the six shortlisted nominations was impressive – ranging from reigniting the Kuarna language, to assisting library borrowers with technology when undertaking chemotherapy for cancer, and one application encompassing 6 different Council libraries in Adelaide to showcase 4,116 events in a 6 month period.

STARTING PRIMARY SCHOOL


In South Australia, the first year of primary school is called reception.

From 2024, children who turn 5 years old:

- before 1 May can start school in term 1
- between 1 May and 31 October can start school in term 3 (mid-year intake)
- after 31 October can start the next year


Children who start school at the beginning of the year will complete 4 terms of reception.

Children who start school in a mid-year intake will complete 6 terms of reception.


